1.	<p>Service Provider Applications upon request will now be able to switch their mode of operations to a FedRAMP-compliant standard where Personal Identifiable Information (PII) and Privilege user's access and controls will be enforced.</p> <p>Under the FedRAMP compliant standard, users and admins will need a FIPS 140-2 compliant authenticator to access applications and PII data.</p> <p>Portal Administrators such as Exostar Portal Admins, Service Provider Admins, Adoption admins, and Org steward due to current access privileges will need to obtain a FIPS 140-2 compliant authenticator to maintain their current level of admin access.</p>	MAG-8125
